Captive populations are only going to succeed if we can maintain an adequate reproductive rate. For this reason we need to promote reproduction in some cases, and moderate it in others. As this is a very specialised field, it is difficult for different institutions to have access to all of the knowledge required for application of the best techniques. The European Group on Zoo Animal Contraception (EGZAC) is a great tool and source of information to aid and promote advances in this field.
